DATE AND VENUE:

Digital: December 2020-September 2021. Practical: October 2021

Modular sessions are digital (each module is 3x2h early evening) and will be recorded and made available to delegates. All the training is in English. The practical sessions will be held in Sweden at Evidensia Specialisthästsjukhuset Strömsholm or Evidensia Specialisthästsjukhuset Helsingborg depending on group assignment. Details on dates and time will be communicated to attendees.

COURSE CONTENT:

Module 1: The anaesthetic machine and monitoring equipment.

Module 2: Pre-anaesthetic assessment and premedication. Intravenous and inhalant anaesthesia.

Module 3: Monitoring the anaesthesia.

Module 4: Analgesia and pain assessment.

Module 5: Fluid therapy and nutritional support.

Module 6: Local anaesthetic drugs. Anaesthetic emergencies.

Module 7: Anaesthetic for specific types of surgery. Field anaesthesia.

Real life experiences and case discussions.

Module 8: The paediatric and pregnant horse. The geriatric horse. The compromised horse - cardiac, renal and liver failure.

Practical session - 2 days: consolidate learning and use new skills in a clinical environment.

Exam: to obtain the certificate.

COURSE FEE:

35.000:- + VAT including 8 digital modules, 2 days practical course, course material and exam. Coffee breaks and lunch during the practical sessions are also included. Travel and accommodation are not included.
